



Criteria for the Consuelo Gomez Arabit award

1. The hospital director/nursing director and the chapter president of the nominees shall endorse the nomination.
2. Nomination shall be based on the noteworthy accomplishment and/or the nominees contributions in nursing, during the recent five (5) years.
3. Nominees will have to submit his/her plan of commitment to his/her profession.
4. Incumbent ORNAP Board of Directors are not to be nominated during his/her term of office.
5. Fill in the nomination form.

QUALIFICATION TOOL FOR CONSUELO ARABIT AWARD

1. Proven Leadership

1.1 Active involvement in ORNAP but not limited to:

- 1.1.1 ORNAP member at least 5 years
- 1.1.2 Active involvement in the ORNAP activities/projects
- 1.1.3 Positions held in ORNAP
- 1.1.4 Attend national conventions, seminar workshops, nursing fora
- 1.1.5 Exercise her right of suffrage during ORNAP elections
- 1.1.6 Holder of current PRC license.

1.2 Empowerment but not limited to:

- 1.2.1 Uphold the life purpose, vision, mission and by-laws of the association
- 1.2.2 Posturing and being able to present ORNAP in other associations and related health agencies.

1.3 Advocacy but not limited to:

- 1.3.1 Initiate/establish linkages/networking with government, non-government agencies and other professional organizations.
- 1.3.2 Lead/initiate/ participate in the position paper and other matters affecting nurses and the nursing profession.
