



As we enter the Golden years of ORNAP, we are now engaged towards honing our young OR Nurses to be Leaders not only in their respective institutions but in the field of PeriOperative nursing as well. Embracing and accepting the challenges that lies yonder and refusing to fail. Adding the culture of Leadership, aiming to empower nurses to be torchbearers in the promotion of PeriOperative safety and wellness.

The ORNAP INC., has triumphantly progressed through the fifty years of its existence. Congratulations to all officers and members which has grown remarkably throughout the country. ORNAP INC. was founded at the time when the image of the OR nurse was low. When people looked at OR nurses as mere "instrument nurse, taga-hugas ng instrument ni Doctor, taga-abot ng instrument without thinking, like a robot" etc. Mrs. Arabit strongly opposed all these labels. Together with Dr. Antonio Oposa, the Medical Director of Johnson and Johnson, the idea of The ORNAP was born. The idea spread and chief nurses from Philippine Heart Center, Meralco Cotton Hospital, Capitol Hospital, Jose Reyes Hospital and Our Lady of Lourdes were the first Board of Directors.

Early on, activities were focused on building the image and competency of the OR Nurse. Sharing BEST Practices was encouraged among OR Nurses in Metro Manila. Hence, meetings were held in different hospitals of the Board of Directors and other forms of avenues where learning was facilitated and enhanced. I initiated the Case Presentation which was participated in by different hospital OR nurses. The best "Case Presentation" of the year would have the chance to present during the Annual Convention. This activity made the OR Nurses more competitive and sharing of expertise soon became automatic. Similarly attendance to Conventions and other training conferences was encouraged. ORNAP was organization accredited to conduct training programs for renewing PRC ID. Eventually ORNAP became a member of the AORN, our counterpart in the US. The first ever Convention outside the US was held here in the Sofitel Hotel with then President Ferdinand Marcos as the Keynote speaker. As ORNAP continued to widen the horizon of the OR NURSES and increase membership/chapters throughout the archipelago, linkages with allied professional organizations began to widen. OR nurses are now participating in the development of guidelines of general use by the OR team, e.g. Infection control of the surgical site, etc. The ORNAP INC. along with ANSAP INC., ADPCN, MCNAP, upon the initiation of PRC, Board of Nursing, jointly conducted research to determine the beginning competencies of a student nurse prior to graduation. So ORNAP is now networking with other organizations not only clinically but in the academe and the Professional Regulatory Commission of the country.

A memorable moment with Mrs. Arabit was when I shared my concept of recognizing "Excellence in Perioperative Nursing Practice" to be named in her honor. Full of emotion, she just said "Thank you for this great honor. Take care of ORNAP. Huwag ninyo pababayaan ang ORNAP." This is the highest award given to qualified members annually. Today we have recognized 24 CGA awardees and a total of 6,197 Members all over the country edifying OR NURSES at its BEST!

On a similar note, many of our OR staff have left the OR Suites and become managers of different healthcare facilities around the country. It is no wonder because of the very nature of the OR as a workplace where things can change in a split second. As the surgeons say, "NO two appendectomies are the same." So the OR nurse can anticipate and act precisely, making them a good manager. Many too have become faculty members of Colleges of Nursing including Graduate Schools. Those who are in the OR have excelled. Do you think any successful surgical procedure no matter how skillful the surgeon is, will happen if the nurse is not as skillful? OR Nurses are undergoing parallel training with that of the surgeon at different levels in different specialties. Just recently, an OR nurse in PGH, ORTHO Department underwent training in Switzerland on ORTHO Trauma Management. She is now recognized as the Philippine Faculty Mentor by Davos Switzerland AO. She currently conducts training programs locally and internationally. This is happening in different departments where special training is required. This parallel training of the surgeon and the OR nurse is a manifestation that the OR nurse is equally contributory to any successful surgery being performed in our country today!

On a personal note, when I was appointed as a member of the PRC Board of Nursing, I said to myself, the "instrument nurse" is now a member of the Regulatory Board! I felt that this is a distinct recognition of the OR NURSE, the indispensable member of any surgical team, who stands by the side of the surgeon in every construction/reconstruction of the human body to make the procedure happen with perfection!

Move on OR NURSES, you are on the right track! Mrs. Consuelo Arabit, thank you for your guidance and trust in me early on in my career. Fifty years passed by swiftly and together with the six thousand-plus members of ORNAP, we humbly say, Mission Accomplished ma'am! To God be the Glory!!!








# PNA COURTESY CALL ORNAP


A fine day of prayer and togetherness binding the whole ORNAP family in selfreflection and rejuvination, immersed to an environment conducive to personal growth and development.
